**Brooklyn, N.Y., June 1, 2008...** Thanks to the research of David Livianu, a New York City resident, hopeful parents and service providers can now expand their research for internationally-adoptable children through a new encyclopedic guide containing 12 volumes and 2 audio library guides, *The 2008 Guide To U.S. and International Adoptions*.

The guide which culminates 7 years of study and travel, details the adoptions laws, orphanages, contacts and fees for adoption in over 150 countries, from Afghanistan to Zimbabwe. Over 16,500 pages, 2,200 mp3 tracks (*more than 50 hours of recorded work*).

According to UNICEF, the United Nations' organization for helping children, there are over 142 million orphans in the world today; "My goal is to bring together loving adoptive parents and orphans of all ages, who have been deprived of the love and nurturing of families", says Romanian-born Livianu, who now resides in Brooklyn with his wife and 2 young children.

"In my research, I have discovered that adoptive parents come in all ages, walks of life, and marital situations; prospective parents may be single or over 40 years of age. In fact, there are many folks in second marriages who wish to help parentless older children", he adds.

"I believe adoptions should always be handled by seasoned adoption service providers, whether a qualified attorney or a certified full fledged adoption agency" recommends Livianu. "This is an educational resources, not a guide to do it alone adoptions!" say Livianu.

David Livianu has been featured on ABC's 20/20 with Barbara Walters, in the heart wrenching documentary "Angels in Adoption"; he has been interviewed by CNN International, AP news, 60 Minutes, The Barry Farber Show and other media outlets.

The 2008 Guide To U.S. and International Adoptions wades through the inter-country bureaucracies and analyzes all 194 countries of the world, whether they allow or not international adoptions, to a detailed analysis of required documents and procedures in specific regions. The material,

though encyclopedic in size and scope, is easily accessible in electronic format, on 2 CDs, 25 separate PDF documents, and 2,241 audio clips for those wishing to listen to the adoption information.

As he introduces his work, Livianu, 52, is also enthusiastic about the potential benefit for the world's large orphan population. "There are so many needy children suffering needlessly around the globe...and so many childless or otherwise child-wanting individuals and families who long for children," Livianu adds.

The 12 PDF volumes and 2 audio libraries, available through Melador Publishers, total a hearty 16,500 pages and 2,241 audio tracks, over 50 hours of recorded materials. See list of below!

"My goal is to educate everyone that wants to learn how to help the orphans in a fast, affordable and civilized manner; adopting parents should always use licensed adoption specialists when pursuing such a special project; however, they should educate themselves in advance and not have to spend \$30,000 and 2 years to complete an adoption; I am 100% committed to making the adoption journey a meaningful and joyous experience for all parents and specialists!" concludes Livianu.





This work is the culmination of a 7 year study by David Livianu, who is also a graduate of the Juilliard School of Music.
